PERFORMANCE DATES

Farmfest opens to the public at 10am on Friday 28th July. Entertainment runs from Midday on Friday 28th until 4am and again from 9.30am on Saturday 29th July until 4am. All customers and performers must be off-site by 2pm on Sunday 30th July. There is no entertainment that day. Where possible we require all arts area acts to arrive on site the day before the festival opens to the public.

PERFORMANCE AREAS

THE PALLADIUM

Dressed in red and gold draping The Palladium has the air of an old speakeasy or cabaret venue. Many acts programmed in this tent are done so with adults in mind, although family friendly entertainment is programmed earlier in the day. The venue houses a stage with a traditional proscenium arch.
